CASTING A VOTE: To vote for the candidate of your choice, darken the response area (●) to the LEFT of the candidate's name. If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the Election Official and obtain another. Do not attempt to erase any marks made in error.

INDEPENDENT STRAIGHT PARTY INSTRUCTIONS: A vote cast for an independent straight party ticket will only be counted for the candidates for President and Vice President or governor and lieutenant governor comprising that independent ticket. This vote will NOT be counted for any OTHER independent candidate appearing on the ballot.

WRITE-IN INSTRUCTIONS: To vote for a write-in candidate, you must make a voting mark on or in the oval to the right of the name you have written in or your vote will not be counted. A write-in vote will NOT be counted unless the vote is for a DECLARED write-in candidate.

STRAIGHT PARTY INSTRUCTIONS: To vote a straight party ticket for all candidates of a political party on this ballot, **except for candidates described below**, make a voting mark on or in this oval and do not make any other marks on this ballot. ***To vote for any candidate for an at-large office (county council, city common council, town council, or township board if those offices appear on this ballot), you must make another voting mark for each candidate you wish to vote for. Your straight party vote will not count as a vote for any candidate for that office.**

*If you wish to vote for a candidate seeking a nonpartisan office or on a public question or judicial retention question, you must make another voting mark on the appropriate place on this ballot.

SPLIT-TICKET VOTING: You may vote a Split Party Ticket by marking ONE of the party choices and then voting for individual candidates of your choice in any other party OR you may vote for individual candidates for your choice in each office.

PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS: A ballot cast for the named candidates for President and Vice President of the United States is considered a ballot cast for the slate of presidential electors nominated by that political party or independent candidate.


